Information on the construction work at Boutique Hotel Bellevue & Alplodge AG

In the adjoining building, right next to the Boutique Hotel Bellevue, there is the traditional restaurant "Goldener Anker". The "Goldener Anker" looks back on a history of over 150 years and is known far beyond the borders of Interlaken. For more than two years the restaurant had been closed and was waiting to be brought back to life. Finally, the wait is over, and the construction work has begun!

On the upper floor of the "Goldener Anker", three spacious double rooms will be built on each of the three floors, as well as two more in the roof floor. The new rooms will also all have balconies with magnificent views of the famous Jungfrau massif. The new rooms will be connected to the Boutique Hotel Bellevue with an entrance. The spacious 4*-star rooms are designed to encourage guests to stay longer in Interlaken.

In the front part of the "Goldener Anker", on the street side of Marktgasse, 9 more rooms in the 2-3* star range are being built, spread over three floors. This will also add new rooms to our Alplodge.

On the ground floor, the traditional restaurant "Goldener Anker" is finally being brought back to life! The reopening of the restaurant will expand the overall culinary offering of Bellevue & Alplodge AG.

The restaurant will be equipped with an outdoor area that should be inviting for a cosy linger during the warm summer nights. Locals as well as guests from far away are all welcome! A cosy get-together with good food, refreshing drinks at a fair price is the aim, the menu is meant to be manageable and yet offer something for every taste.

The reconstruction is scheduled to be completed in 2023.
